Mulch Bag Types: (Note: Each 1.5 cubic foot (cf) bag covers approximately 9 sq. ft., 2" deep)



Queen City Gold – Natural (1.5 cf bags)

This is the most popular mulch, triple shredded and dark brown in color, spreads easily, and gives your landscape a beautiful, finished look.



Black Dyed Double Shredded (1.5 cf bags)

All dyed mulch is processed with a water based dye. It will hold color longer than the natural hardwood mulch. It accentuates flowers and leaves, making your landscape beds the talk of the neighborhood.



Cedar Mulch (2 cf bags)

This mulch is made from shredded cedar and a rich light brown in color. It is slow to decompose and it holds up and looks great for a long time.



Pine Bark Mini Nuggets (2 cf bags)

These shredded pine bark nuggets are slow to decompose and provide a long-lasting dark brown color. All chips of Southern pine bark hold up great and look fantastic all season.



Pine Straw Bales (Covers about 35 sq.ft. at 3" deep)

New option, pine straw has been used in the south for years and is gaining popularity in our area. Pine straw adheres well on sloped surfaces where conventional mulch may wash out.

For those interested in a bulk order, a different mulch offering, or other landscaping products customers can purchase gift cards in increments of \$50 with part of the proceeds going directly to the Troop. Bulk deliveries can be coordinated directly through Bzak.
